

Dear KIS Parents,

This letter is to inform you that we have installed ID card readers in all of our school buses to better ensure the safety of our students.

Beginning October 4th, 2016, all KIS students who ride a school bus should use their ID card to tag it on the card reader on the bus. By doing so, parents will be able to check their child's location in real time.

To check the student's real-time location, parents need to use the Hello Bus App. Please see below for registration procedures.

1. Enter student information

www.kis.kr → ABOUT US → BUSING → Application Forms → Select [2016-17 Hello Bus Application Form] and enter student information / agree to use private information → Click SUBMIT (It will take about 24 hours to complete the registration process)

2. Download the app and install

Search for "hello bus" from Google App Store / Apple Store, download, and install. (You'll need to get a confirmation number from school to complete the installation)

A mini-card will be distributed to the ES bus riders to prevent them from losing their school ID cards by carrying it around (mini-card will be free for the 1st time). MS and HS students can use their regular school ID card.

KIS will continue to do our best to provide safe and convenient school bus service. We hope to have the best transportation system possible for our families.
